## YAMAMOTO SHOTEN

Yamamoto Shoten, opened in 1909, is a used bookstore that mainly handles classics, including books with stitched bindings. It focuses particularly on China-related books and calligraphy, and is one of Japan's most renowned shops selling imported books that have been reprinted in Japan. The proprietor says this store is unique because "customers can quietly browse to find the book they want." People also contact this store for materials needed to make documentaries and calligraphy examples.

### **IIJIMA SHOTEN**

This well-known store specializes in calligraphy. On the wall you will find texts on from volumes to journals as well as how to books, all related to the art of calligraphy. In the center of the store is a large display case that contains three types of important items related to the art, "Suiteki" (Water droppers, vassals for adding moisture to the ink stone), "Houcho" (Text books for practicing calligraphy), and "Takuhon" (Stone rubbings/ Etchings). Due to the concerns of damage to historical artifacts, many of these stone rubbings are considered rare.

Located on Suzuran Dori behind the Sanseido main book store, climb the steep stairs to the second floor to go back in movie history. Inside you will find scripts, magazines, journals, screen plays and more dedicated to both Japanese and overseas films. Looking for old European movie related paraphernalia, then check out the table in the center of the store. Books about costumes, props as well as certain genres can be found as well as a large selection dedicated to Nouvelle Cinema and art house films.

### **SEISHINDO SHOTEN**

One of the longest established bookstores in the Jinboucho area, this book specializes in Japanese style books which include books from the beginning of the Edo period (1603-1868) to the present day, over 1000 items. They also have a high quality selection of academic materials. ### TAMURA SHOTEN

Located on the 5th floor of the Kanda Jimbocho Kosho Center, this store mainly sells mineral specimens, gemstones, and antiques. Inside the store, glossy gemstones, fashionable and cute items with motifs of mushrooms and frogs are displayed nicely, making you want to take a good closer look around.
