




⑧ IIJIMA SHOTEN

In the center of the store is a large display case that contains three types of important items related to the art, "Suiteki" (Water droppers, vassals for adding moisture to the ink stone), "Houcho" (Text books for practicing calligraphy), and "Takuhon" (Stone rubbings/ Etchings). Due to the concerns of damage to historical artifacts, many of these stone rubbings are considered rare.


YAGUCHI SHOTEN
